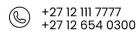




## How To Guide | Cash Office Cashup

1. After Till Cashup has been completed, open Genesis Menu.

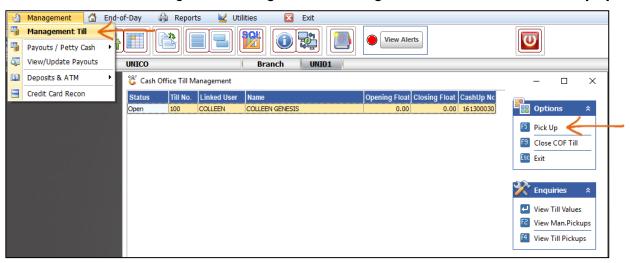

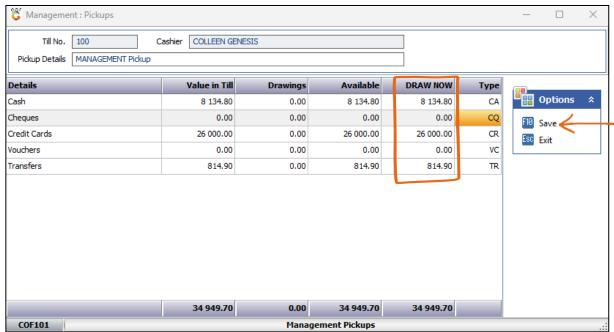
2. Open the Cash Office Module



3. To start off the Cash Office Cashup, you will need to process the Management Pickups. In the Cash Office module navigate to Management > Management Till > Click on the Pickup option.

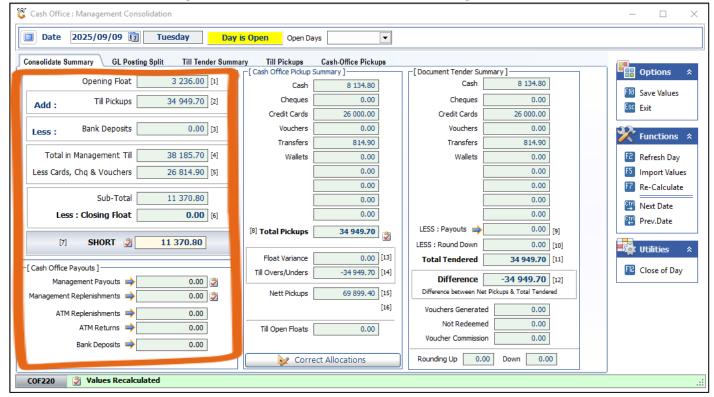


4. In the Management Till Pickup screen, enter the **total values counted from the Till pickups** in the relevant Tender Option under the **DRAW NOW heading** and **save the pickup** values once done.

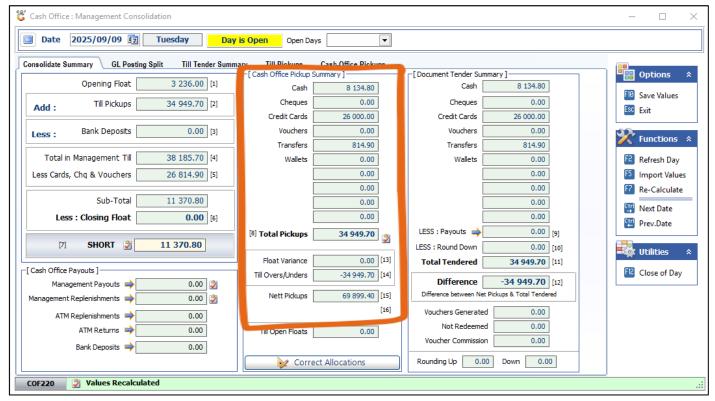


After doing the Management Pickup, navigate to the End-Of-Day tab > Consolidation and Close of Day

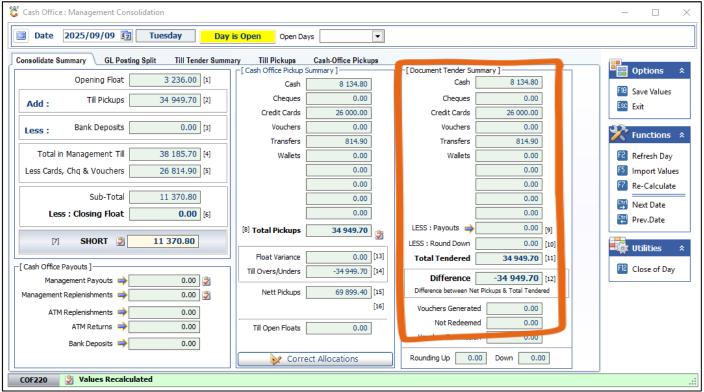
**Explanation of Consolidate Summary Screen** 



- First highlighted values represent the total physical Cash on Premises excluding the floats in the Tills. This is also excluding money in the Drop Safe and money banked.
  - Opening Float: Total physical Cash at the start of the day for the whole store
  - Add: Till Pickups: This is the total pickups done from the Tills
  - Less: Bank Deposits: Bank Deposits get deducted from opening Float
  - o Total in Management Till: Total in the Cash office till after Cash office pickup
  - Less Cards, Chq & Vouchers: Virtual money is subtracted from the management Till as it is not physical cash on hand.
  - o **Sub-Total:** This is what the Total closing float of the business should be for the day.
  - o Less-Closing Float: Manually enter the true count of physical cash on premises here.
  - o Short: Difference between system calculated sub-total and closing float.
- **Management Payouts:** This is where the Cash Office user goes to view or process payouts from the Cash Office. This deducts from the Float of the business.
- **Management Replenishments:** This is money brought into the Cash Office from external sources, i.e. Not from the Tills.
- ATM Replenishments: Remove money from the business float to put in ATM inside the Shop.
- ATM Returns: To return money from the ATM into the business float.
- Bank Deposits: Cash money deposited in the Drop Safe.

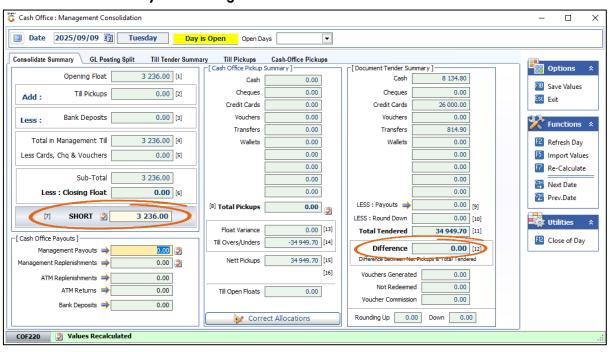


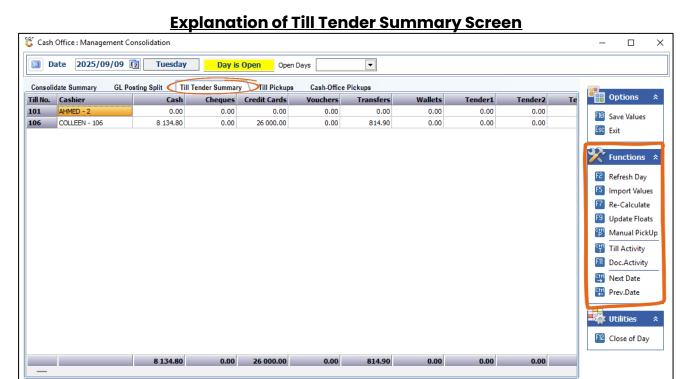
- Cash Office Pickup Summary: These values represent the total of each tender type collected by the Cash Office (From Cash to Wallets)
- **Float Variance:** This is the difference between the Opening and Closing Floats on the Tills compared to the previous trading date's floats.
- **Tills Overs/Unders:** This is the Overs and Unders of the Tills based on the transaction activity versus the Till pickups.
- Nett Pickups: This is the Total pickups after Tills overs and unders are deducted.



- Document Tender Summary: These are the sum of each tender method selected when sales were
  done at the Tills that day (From Cash to Wallets)
- Less: Payouts: This is the total value of the Payouts/Disbursements done across all Tills. This gets deducted from the Total document tender summary.
- Less: Round Down: This the total of all rounding across all sales.
- Total Tendered: Sum of all Tender Types less payouts and less round down.
- **Difference:** It is the difference between Total Tendered and Nett Pickups.
- Vouchers Generated: Total Value of vouchers Generated for the day.
- Not Redeemed: Total Value of non-redeemed vouchers for the day.

## 5.2.1 <u>Note:</u> You ideally want the closing float on the left of the screen and the difference on the right of the screen to be zero. This indicates the day is balancing.





To investigate Till Overs and Unders, navigate to the Till Tender Summary tab.

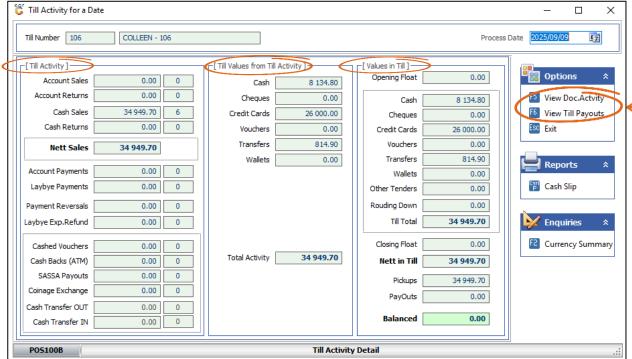
• Refresh Day: Refreshes the till values for the day.

COF220 Values Recalculated

- Import Values: Imports all figures for all tills for the day.
- Re-Calculate: Recalculates the figures for the day based on tender methods and pickups.
- Update Floats: Allows you to adjust the opening and closing floats for a till for the day.
- Manual Pickup: Allows you to do a pickup on a till in case it was not done.
- Till Activity: Allows you to view the overall movement of funds in the till for the day.
- **Doc Activity:** Lets you drill down into each document processed on a till which displays the tender method used.
- Next Date: Moves to the next day's Cashup figures.
- Prev Date: Moves to the previous day's Cashup figures.

## **Explanation of Till Activity Screen**

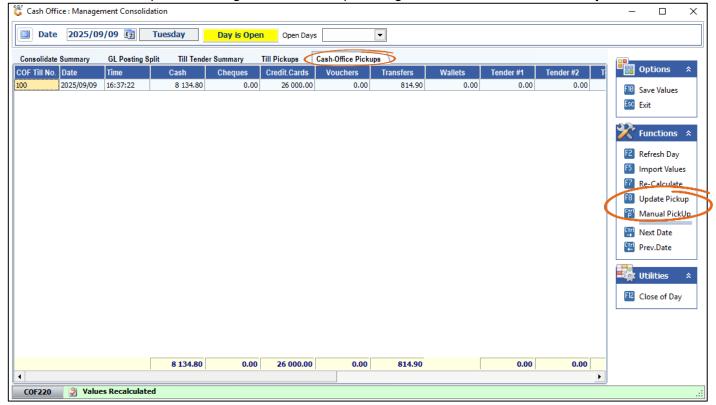


- Till Activity: The sum of each document type processed on the till for the day.
- Till Values from Till Activity: The sum of the Tenders processed on the till.
- **Values in Till:** The values that are left in the till ready to be picked up. This will show your shorts and overs based on Till Pickups.
- **F5 View Doc. Activity:** Allows you to view the documents processed on the till and shows you what tender method was selected for individual documents.
- F6 View Till Payouts: Allows you to view the payouts processed on that till for the day.

  NOTE: If any changes are made to pickup values, you can recalculate the short or over in this screen by pressing CTRL + U on your keyboard.
- 7. You can view the till pickups from the **Till Pickups** tab. You can update the pickup as well from here.

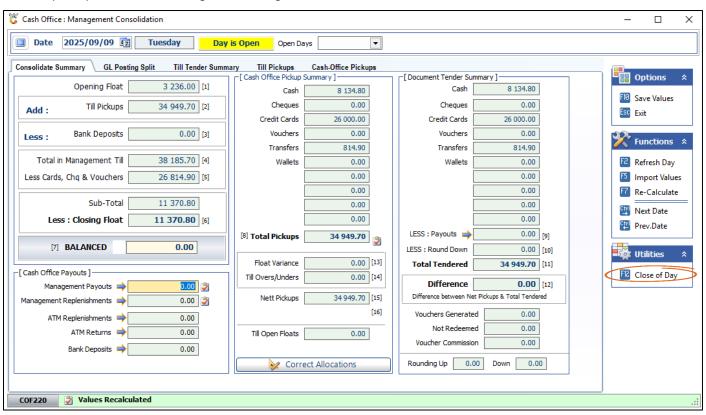


8. To View and Update Management Till Pickups, navigate to the Cash-Office Pickups tab.



## 9. Close of Day

Provided all your values on the Consolidate Summary tab are balancing, you can proceed to close the day for trade using the **Close of Day** option on the bottom right of the screen. This will post your sales to the general ledger.
